Our Rationale



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1. Forming a multi-academy trust is a natural next step for the current collaboration of schools working together for the benefit of the young people in the community.
2. Bringing a formality to this loose arrangement will allow for greater inter-school working and sharing of best practice across a relatively close geographical area.
3. Our vision of 'excellence through partnership' encapsulates the core purpose of forming the Trust, since all our schools are fully committed to ensuring that leadership, teaching, learning, outcomes and behaviour are of the highest possible quality.

- *Community* – committed [to building a cohesive, inclusive and high achieving community] - providing opportunities for the wider community

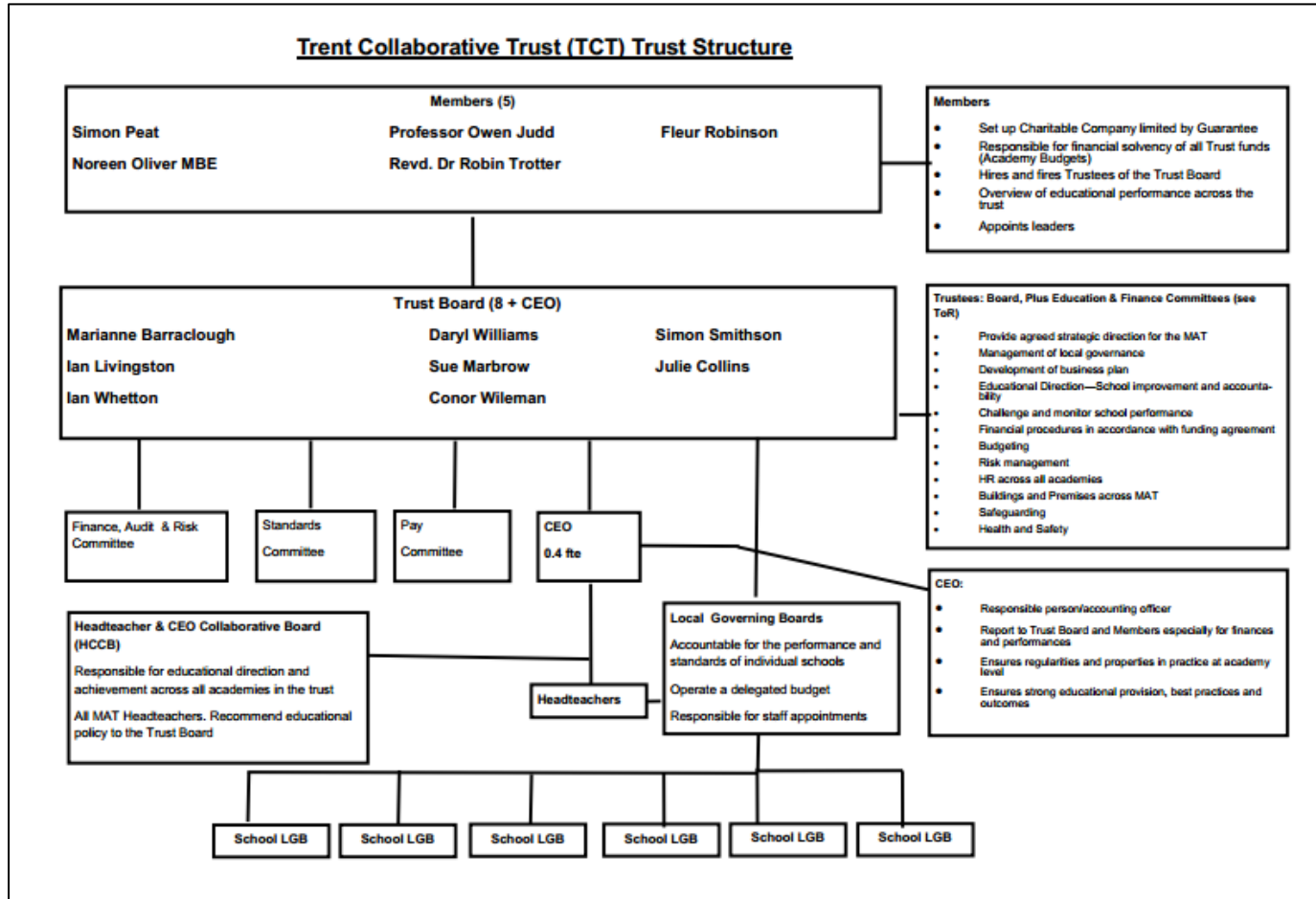


Governance for the Trent Collaborative Trust
