



Year 7 Catch-Up Premium 2016-17 planned spending

Estimated Catch –Up Premium funding £11,500

The Year 7 Catch-Up Premium will be used by Abbot Beyne to deliver additional tuition or intensive support in small groups, giving students valuable support to bring them up to speed so that they are more likely to succeed.

The government allocated a maximum of £500 in respect of each student who was at a maintained school in Year 6 who had not attained the national floor standard in reading and/or mathematics. That standard has been set at a score of 100. The Year 7 Catch-Up funding is to be used by Abbot Beyne to provide literacy and numeracy catch-up support for Year 7 students. It will enable those students that did not achieve the floor standard score of 100 in reading and/or mathematics at Key Stage 2 to be given the opportunity to catch up as quickly as possible.
