



Year 7 Catch-Up Premium 2015-16 Evaluation

In 2015-16 we received £11,500 in catch up funding. This money is given to schools by the Department for Education to support Year 7 students who arrive at Abbot Beyne below a Level 4 (age expected standard)

This money was used to:

1. Provide an additional literacy class in Year 7
2. Increase Maths staffing in the lowest set in Year 7
3. Provide some small group intervention classes
4. Ensure that students participated in the Accelerated Reader programme

Maths students

16 students arrived below a Level 4 (ranging from Level 2 to 3a)

6 students reached level 4 by the end of Year 7.

The average sub level of progress for these 16 students was 1.25. The figure for the whole of Year 7 was 1.47

English students

15 students arrived below a Level 4 (ranging from Level 2 to 3a)

6 students reached level 4 by the end of Year 7.

The average sub level of progress for these 16 students was 1.9. The figure for the whole of Year 7 was 0.89
